<b>Appearance</b> The wine is deep ruby ✓✓	<b>2</b>
<b>Nose</b> For aroma descriptors there are a maximum of 5 marks available. Think in terms of primary, secondary and tertiary as appropriate.	<b>7 Marks</b>
(primary) ✓ The wine has a medium (+) intensity of aroma. Aromas include primary notes of blackcurrant, red cherry, black cherry, black plum, green bell pepper, mint. Oak influence gives notes of vanilla cedar and smoke. Bottle age has given aromas of leather, tobacco, prune and cooked plums, the wine is therefore developing. ✓ (secondary) ✓ (tertiary) ✓	<b>7</b>
<b>Palate</b> For flavour descriptors there are a maximum of 3 marks available. Think in terms of primary, secondary and tertiary as appropriate.	<b>10 Marks</b>
✓✓✓ The wine is dry with high acid and high tannins. The alcohol is medium, and the body is medium (+) the aroma intensity is medium (+). Aromas include primary notes of blackcurrant, red cherry, black cherry, black plum, green bell pepper, mint. Oak influence gives notes of vanilla cedar and smoke. Bottle age has given aromas of leather, tobacco, prune and cooked plums. The wine has a medium (+) finish. ✓ (primary) ✓ (secondary) ✓ (tertiary) ✓	<b>10</b>
